Despite diligent efforts, the Registrant is unable to file its Annual Report on Form 10-K for the fiscal year ended December 31, 2019 (the "Form 10-K") by the prescribed due date as a result of unexpected delays in the completion of its financial statements and related portions of the Form 10-K. The delay is primarily due to the impact of shelter at home on work efficiency and the Registrant's need for additional time to prepare and review certain information and complete its review of its financial statements and other disclosures in the Form 10-K, including without limitation regarding assessing the impact of the recent coronavirus outbreak and declared national emergency, and related state actions, on the financial statements and other disclosures in the Form 10-K in light of, among other things, recent statements from the Securities and Exchange Commission and the Public Company Accounting Oversight Board. Such delays could not be eliminated without unreasonable effort and expense. The Registrant anticipates that it will file its Form 10-K for the fiscal year ended December 31, 2019 within the fifteen calendar day extension period provided by Rule 12b-25.
